DCS Student Saddle Bronc Champ!

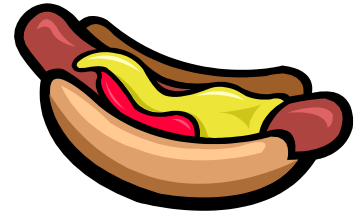

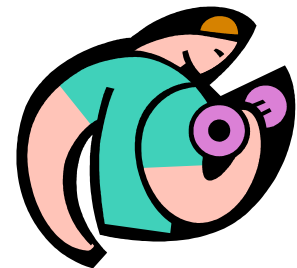
