- Delburne Centralized School is a non-smoking, and scent free school. We are also "nut aware" because we do have students with severe nut allergies. We have a NO head wear policy in the hallways and classrooms. Cell phones & music devices may be used at the discretion of the individual teacher as long as they do not disrupt the learning of others.
- Locks are available at the main office to purchase for \$6.00.
- We have the Community Fitness Centre above the large gymnasium. Memberships are available for students 14 years and older at \$10.00 a year, and adult memberships are **\$60.00** for September – June. The hours are 8:00 a.m. – 8:30 p.m. on school days only. Students must have adult supervision after 4:00 p.m.
- The Breakfast program operates each day. Students are encouraged to use it.
- Hot dog day is every Wednesday and Hot lunch is available on Fridays. The hot dogs are \$1.50 each and the hot lunch is between \$3.25 - \$9.00, depending on the lunch offered that Friday.
