






High School students, or those entering grade 10 in September 2019, are able to take courses to upgrade existing marks, complete a required course missing from their timetable, or for personal reasons. Students work at their own pace, but under the guidance and supervision of teachers who provide assistance when needed. All core high school courses are offered and there is no charge for students currently in Chinook's Edge.

Taking a summer course provides students the opportunity to upgrade their marks in a course they didn't do well in, or it can help reduce their course load in September.
