### SHELTER IN PLACE, SECURE OUR SCHOOLS and LOCKDOWN

During an emergency, our school and our Division's first priority is the safety of its students and staff. To provide an effective response to any school crisis, both Delburne Centralized School and Chinook's Edge School Division have developed an Emergency Response Plan. The plan works in conjunction with other local emergency plans, as a school emergency could require the involvement of numerous agencies. Both individual school plans and the Division's plan are reviewed annually.

Depending on the situation, different directions may be given. Please see the summary below to help differentiate between these directions.

**SHELTER IN PLACE-** this is used when we need to control movement in the hallways due to situations such as an injury or a chemical spill. Shelter in Place could also be used due to severe weather or an air quality event.

**SECURE OUR SCHOOLS-** this is used when there is a security situation or criminal activity located outside of the school. During a Secure Our Schools, all exterior doors will be locked and no one will be permitted in or out of the building (other than law enforcement).

**LOCKDOWN-** this is used in response to acts or threats of violence towards students and staff when there is a safety risk inside the building and directly impacting the school. During a lockdown, all students and staff immediately proceed to the nearest lockable area and all interior doors are locked. Students remain quiet and hidden and no one is permitted in or out of the area that has been locked (other than law enforcement).

### MADD PRESENTATION

Our High School students took part in a powerful *Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) presentation* earlier today. The presentation showed a dramatization focused on the tragic consequences of impaired driving. We will continue to provide information and education for our students to set them up to make safe, informed choices.

### MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS PRESENTATION
