STUDENT SUPPORT

Over the past few months, we have been able to offer a wide variety of presentations in an effort to inform and educate our DCS students. Some of the presentations that we have been fortunate enough to have include:

- Brett Gardiner has joined us for a series of presentations focused on mental health and wellness for our students in Grades 7-12.
- An Alberta Health Vaping and Tobacco Safety presentation for students in Grades 7-12. This presentation covered trends, statistics and risks associated with vaping and tobacco use.
- A Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) presentation for our Grade 9-12 students. This presentation provided a powerful dramatization about the tragic consequences of impaired driving.
- The Outreach Centre delivered a two session program called "It's OK to Talk about Suicide" for our Grade 9-12 students. This presentation educated students on mental health in general, coping skills, myths and facts surrounding suicide.
- Healthy Dating Relationships 101 for our Gr. 7-12 students. This program discussed healthy youth dating relationships, empowering students to build and maintain healthy and respectful dating relationships.
- "iRespect" for our Grade 4-6 students. This program empowered students to grow self-esteem and respect for themselves as well as understand concepts including body boundaries, communication, varied emotions, labels and stereotypes and diversity/inclusion.
- A wide variety of presentations focused on career connections and post secondary planning. These presentations have provided our students with detailed information about the programs available for students as they enter life after High School.
- Later in the month of March, we look forward to an RCMP presentation focused on Internet Safety for our Grade 4-8 students as well as a Drug Safety and Awareness presentation for our High School students.

As we move into the latter half of our school year, we will continue to bring guest speakers and presentations to our students so they can make informed, responsible choices and decisions.
