What is a Gaga Pit you ask? Gaga ball is a fast-paced dodgeball game captivating playgrounds across the country. The game is played in an octagonal or hexagonal pit. The walls of the pit serve as boundaries, and players must stay inside the pit while playing. If a player is hit by the soft foam ball or if they hit the ball out of bounds, they are eliminated from the game. The last player remaining in the pit is the winner.

Gaga ball is popular among children, teenagers, and adults alike because it is easy to learn, requires minimal equipment, and promotes physical activity and social interaction. It is commonly played in schools, camps, community centers, and recreational areas. We can't wait to see this game in action next year!!!
